MOBILE PHONES AND SMART WATCHES

PURPOSE

To explain to our school community Deepdene Primary School's policy requirements, and expectations regarding the safe and appropriate use of mobile phones and smart watches by students, at school or during school activities.

SCOPE

This policy applies to:

1. All students at Deepdene Primary School and,
2. Students' personal mobile phone and smart watches

DEFINITIONS

A mobile phone is a telephone with access to a cellular (telecommunication) system, with or without a physical connection to a network. For the purpose of this policy, "mobile phone" refers to mobile phones and any device that may connect to or have a similar functionality to a mobile phone such as smart watches.

POLICY

Deepdene Primary School understands that students may bring a mobile phone to school, particularly if they are travelling independently to and from school or to extra-curricular activities.

At Deepdene Primary School:

- Students who choose to bring mobile phones to school must have them switched off and securely stored during school hours (handed in to the class teacher)
- Exceptions to this policy may be applied if certain conditions are met (see below for further information)
- When emergencies occur, parents or carers should reach their child by calling the school's office.

Personal mobile phone use

In accordance with the Department's [Mobile Phones — Student Use Policy](#) issued by the Minister for Education, personal mobile phones must not be used at Deepdene Primary School during school hours, including lunchtime and recess, unless an exception has been granted.

Where a student has been granted an exception, the student must use their mobile phone for the purpose for which the exception was granted, and in a safe, ethical and responsible manner.



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Smart watches use

Smart watches are not be worn at school or during school activities at any time.

During school hours parents should contact the school office if they need to communicate with their child.

Secure storage

Mobile phones owned by students at Deepdene Primary School are considered valuable items and are brought to school at the owner’s (student’s or parent/carer’s) risk. Students are encouraged not to bring a mobile phone to school unless there is a compelling reason to do so. Please note that Deepdene Primary School does not have accident insurance for accidental property damage or theft. Students and their parents/carers are encouraged to obtain appropriate insurance for valuable items. Refer to the Department’s [Claims for Property Damage and Medical Expenses policy](#).

Where students bring a mobile phone to school, Deepdene Primary School will provide secure storage. Secure storage is storage that cannot be readily accessed by those without permission to do so. At Deepdene Primary School students are required to store their phones with their teacher in a lockable cupboard.

Enforcement

Students who use their personal mobile phones inappropriately at Deepdene Primary School may be issued with consequences consistent with our school’s existing student engagement polices *e.g. Student Wellbeing and Engagement Policy* and *Bullying Prevention Policy*.

At Example School inappropriate use of mobile phones is **any use during school hours**, unless an exception has been granted, and particularly use of a mobile phone:

- in any way that disrupts the learning of others
- to send inappropriate, harassing or threatening messages or phone calls
- to engage in inappropriate social media use including cyber bullying
- to capture video or images of people, including students, teachers and members of the school community without their permission
- to capture video or images in the school toilets, changing rooms, swimming pools and gyms
- during exams and assessments

Exceptions

Exceptions to the policy:

- may be applied during school hours if certain conditions are met, specifically,
 - Health and wellbeing-related exceptions; and
 - Exceptions related to managing risk when students are offsite.
- can be granted by the Principal, or by the teacher for that class, in accordance with the Department’s [Mobile Phones — Student Use Policy](#).

The three categories of exceptions allowed under the Department’s [Mobile Phones — Student Use Policy](#) are:

1. Learning-related exceptions

Specific exception	Documentation
For specific learning activities (class-based exception)	Unit of work, learning sequence
For students for whom a reasonable adjustment to a learning program is needed because of a disability or learning difficulty	Individual Learning Plan, Individual Education Plan



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2. Health and wellbeing-related exceptions

Specific exception	Documentation
Students with a health condition	Student Health Support Plan
Students who are Young Carers	A localised student record

3. Exceptions related to managing risk when students are offsite

Specific exception	Documentation
Travelling to and from excursions	Risk assessment planning documentation
Students on excursions and camps	Risk assessment planning documentation
When students are offsite (not on school grounds) and unsupervised with parental permission	Risk assessment planning documentation
Students with a dual enrolment or who need to undertake intercampus travel	Risk assessment planning documentation

Where an exception is granted, the student can only use the mobile phone for the purpose for which it was granted.

Camps and Excursions

In most circumstances, students will not be allowed to bring their smart watches or mobile phones on overnight school camps or excursions. Deepdene Primary School will provide students and their parents and carers with information about items that can be brought to special activities and events, including smart watches and mobile phones.

Exclusions

This policy does not apply to

- Out-of-School-Hours Care (OSHC)
- Out-of-school-hours events
- Travelling to and from school
